

Petition: Ask State Legislators and Gov. Little to Protect Children from School and Library Pornography

In 1972, the Idaho Legislature recognized that obscene materials “are a contributing factor to crime, to juvenile crime, and also a basic factor in impairing the ethical and moral development of our youth” (§ 18-1513, Idaho Code).

Despite the clear harm caused by pornography to children, families, and society, more than fifty school and public libraries continue making sexual materials available to minor children.

In recent years, parents have expressed the urgent need for legislative reform to address the proliferation of pornography in schools and libraries. Their concerns are echoed by the general public, with nearly 74% of likely Idaho voters agreeing that schools and libraries should protect children from sexually explicit content.

With this in mind, we call on the Idaho Legislature and Governor Brad Little to restrict children’s access to obscene materials in taxpayer-funded schools and libraries, thereby fulfilling their constitutionally mandated responsibility to promote public virtue and morality (Idaho Const. art. 3, § 24.).
