Select the presentation(s) from IFPC President Blaine Conzatti that you'd like to consider:

- Biblical Foundations: The Christian Founding of Idaho (approximately 45 minutes).** Christian conservatives cherish the U.S. Constitution, but most have never thought to study their state constitutions. In this presentation, Blaine shares stories illustrating how biblical principles shaped Idaho's founding—all with the goal of inspiring audiences to renew their commitment to passing the torch of liberty to the next generation. - The Lie of Separation of Church and State: Reclaiming God's Place in Government (approximately 45 minutes).** Did our founding fathers build a strict separation of church and state into our constitution? And what does the Bible say about the responsibility of Christians to influence politics with biblical truth? In this presentation, Blaine explains what religious freedom really means and why the Christian church must serve as the conscience of the state today.
- Biblical Citizenship: The Cultural Mandate of the Great Commission (approximately 45 minutes).** Modern Christians have truncated the Gospel to mere evangelism, reducing the biblical message into nothing more than saving souls from hell. But Christians throughout church history understood that the biblical Gospel was about bringing the Word of God to bear on all of life—including culture, government, and politics. In this presentation, Blaine explains why the responsibility of Christians to exercise the responsibilities of biblical citizenship is essential to the Great Commission.
- Biblical Citizenship: Defending Preborn Life (approximately 45 minutes).** The battle to protect preborn life is heating up. This especially the case here in Idaho, where voters will soon decide whether to adopt a pro-abortion ballot initiative. In this presentation, Blaine explores the biblical case for defending preborn children, provides an overview of Idaho abortion law, and equips audiences to engage faithfully on this defining issue.
- Biblical Citizenship: Addressing Obscene Materials in Public Schools and Community Libraries (approximately 45 minutes).** For years, most parents thought that public schools and community libraries were safe places for their children to learn and explore. But these parents are now shocked to learn that some school and library collections contain sexually explicit materials, much of which can be accessed by minor children. In this presentation, Blaine shares the policy and court battles over sexually explicit library materials—and how parents can use a new state law, called the Children's School and Library Protection Act, to protect children in their communities.
- Legislative Session Updates (approximately 15-30 minutes).** Blaine provides updates on the most recent legislative session—equipping audiences with an inside look at key policy battles, major legislative victories, and practical ways citizens can engage effectively in the public square.
